

Dear Parents and Carers,

A warm welcome to all of our new children in Nursery, Reception, Year 3 and Year 5 who have joined us last week, it has been lovely meeting you all on the gate each morning. I know that your child will be very happy at Holy Spirit.

In our welcome back assembly last week our children were reminded of our school behaviour policy and the expectations of this. Children can earn up to 5 minutes towards Fun Friday each day—please support your child to follow our school behaviour policy and SOAR this school year in everything that they do!





Our earlier time to school has helped all of the children have a much more settled start to the day—we have a few children still arriving after 8:45am, please note that your child will receive a late mark if they are not in school on time. The school gate opens promptly at 8:35am and closes at 8:45am. By 8:45am your child should be in class where their teacher will be completing the school register.

Breakfast club is available to book through the school office from 7:45am each morning at the cost of :

Daily rate (one child) - £3 per child, per day

Daily rate (for 2 siblings) - £2.50 per child, per day

Daily rate (for 3 siblings) - £2.00 per child, per day

We work so hard with our school attendance and punctuality at Holy Spirit—it has been disappointing this week to receive requests that children are going on holidays during term time. Please look at our school holidays and try and book any holidays during these times. Your child is missing key learning in school when you take them out of school. You could also end up receiving a fine by the Local Authority.

Your child will have brought home their reading record last week in Years 1–6, please make sure this is returned to school throughout the week and that your child is reading at home. Reading is such an important skill that your child needs in order to access all of their learning—we appreciate all of your support with this.
















































Attendance and Punctuality
