## **SCHOOL LEVY**

The responsibility for the upkeep of the buildings of Catholic Schools lies with the Archdiocese who administers the funding provided by the government.

To maintain and refurbish the schools in our area, the Archdiocese ask parents to contribute to a fund known as the **School Levy**, which pays the 10% contribution required by the DFE and guarantees our access to the funding.
